## **FIRST STEPS**

What is First Steps?

First Steps is a statewide early intervention system that provides services to children with developmental disabilities and their families. Some babies may have

trouble developing certain skills. Parents are often the first to notice when their child is not learning or growing like other infants or toddlers they know. If you have concerns about your baby or toddler's growth and development First Steps can help. Services are available to any child and family who meet developmental eligibility criteria, regardless of income.

Who can participate?

First Step screening can begin at birth to age 3. Your child must be screened by First Steps to determine if he or she is eligible for the program. If the screening identifies that your child does have some developmental concerns then you will be given the choice to have your child evaluated. This evaluation will give families information about how their child is developing in the following areas: communication, mobility (movement, walking, and use of hands), cognition (knowledge, awareness, perception, and judgment), social or emotional, and adaptive (self-help skills). Children who receive a diagnosis of a physical or mental condition with high probability of resulting developmental delay, such as Down Syndrome automatically qualify for the program.

## **IMPACT Program**

What is the IMPACT Program?

Sometimes the best medicine is a home remedy, especially if it means keeping a child with a severe emotional disability out of a psychiatric hospital or other restrictive treatment facility. Although some children do require hospitalization, most children have a better chance of doing their best when they receive care at or near their home, surrounded by a loving family and supportive community. That's where Interagency Mobilization for Progress in Adolescent and Children's Treatment (IMPACT) can help. IMPACT helps create and coordinate services that allow a child with an emotional disability to receive care at home or in their community.

Who can participate?

Children must meet all of the following requirements:

1. Must be under age 18 or
2. Under age 21 if services began before age 18 and it is determined that services should be continued for maximum therapeutic benefit
3. Must have a diagnosis of a psychiatric disorder. Diagnosis of chemical dependency, mental retardation or other brain disorder may be present, but cannot be the primary diagnosis
4. Must be severely limited in at least two of the following areas:
  - a. Self-care: Providing for and protecting oneself in an age-appropriate manner
  - b. Interpersonal relationships: Building and keeping good relationships with adults and other children
  - c. Family life: Living in a non-abusive or non-negligent family environment

- d. Self-direction: Using age-appropriate self-control and judgment
- e. Education: Learning social and intellectual skills from teachers and other adults and remaining involved in school
- f. Risk: Must have been disabled for at least one year or judged by a qualified mental health professional to be at high risk to continue in the disability for one year or more without intervention.
- g. Service coordination: Must require service coordination and service planning from two or more agencies at the same time.

Court Designated Worker Program  
What is the Court Designated Worker Program?

Court Designated Workers (CDW) help children and teens that are in trouble. CDW's process complaints filed against youth. These complaints fall into two categories: status and public offenses. Status offenses are noncriminal forms of juvenile behavior, such as running away from home, skipping class, tobacco offenses or exhibiting beyond-control behaviors at home or school. Public offenses are defined in the same terms as adult charges. Juveniles involved in minor offenses are generally eligible for informal processing and enter into diversion agreements. A diversion agreement is a negotiated contract between the CDW and youth that is designated to educate, instill a sense of accountability and deter young people from getting into further trouble. CDW's use prevention, education, accountability and referral to treatment (if applicable) to resolve a complaint. The CDW monitors diversion

agreements which may last up to six months, to ensure youth comply with the conditions. If a young person successfully completes the agreement, the case is dismissed. If he or she fails to comply with the conditions of the diversion agreement, the case will be set for formal proceedings.
